### How Religion Tries to Steal What it Did Not – and Cannot – Earn for Itself

John 9:35 - 10:2

The greatest opponent to the new and living way Jesus offers is the old and dead way of religion. 

- 35 Jesus heard that they had put him out, and finding him, He said, "Do you believe in the Son of Man?"
- 36 He answered, "Who is He, that I may believe in Him?"
- 37 Jesus said to him, "You have both seen Him, and He is the one who is talking with you."

- 38 And he said, "Lord, I believe." And he worshipped Him.
- 39 And Jesus said, "For judgment I came into this world, so that those who do not see may see, and that those who see may become blind."

- 40 Those of the Pharisees who were with Him heard these things and said to Him, "We are not blind too, are we?"
- 41 Jesus said to them, "If you were blind, you would have no sin; but since you say, 'We see', your sin remains.

- 01 "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who does not enter by the door into the fold of the sheep, but climbs up some other way, he is a thief and a robber.
- 02 "But he who enters by the door is a shepherd of the sheep."


### "We are not blind, are we?"

- "If you were blind" = if you closed your eyes to the futility of being good enough on your own merit
- "fruit of the poisoned tree"
- The sheep pen = the kingdom of God: righteousness, peace and joy



07 – So Jesus said to them again, "Truly, truly, I say to you, I am the door of the sheep.
08 – "All who came before Me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not hear them.

09 - "I am the door; if anyone enters through Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture."



# A relationship with Jesus is the door to the kingdom of God!

- Jesus makes it personal!
- Religion = Arrogance
- Relationship = Humility

#### Denial of sin

"I'm a good person/I'm not as bad as some people."

#### **Outward appearances**

hypocrisy/judgementalism

#### **Empty traditions**

"Because it's what we've always done."

#### Pride

Refusal to repent when confronted with sin

The 8<sup>th</sup> Commandment


Not steal

#### James 1

- 25 But one who looks intently at the perfect law, the law of liberty, and abides by it, this man will be blessed in what he does.

- 10 By this will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.
- 11 Every priest stands daily ministering and offering time after time the same sacrifices...

- 11 ...which can never take away sins;
- 12 but He, having offered one sacrifice for sins for all time, sat down at the right hand of God...
- 14 For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified...

- 19 Therefore, brethren, since we have confidence to enter the holy place by the blood of Jesus,
- 20 by <u>a new and living way</u> which He inaugurated for us through the veil, that is, His flesh,

- 21 and since we have a great priest over the house of God,
- 22 let us draw near with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.
